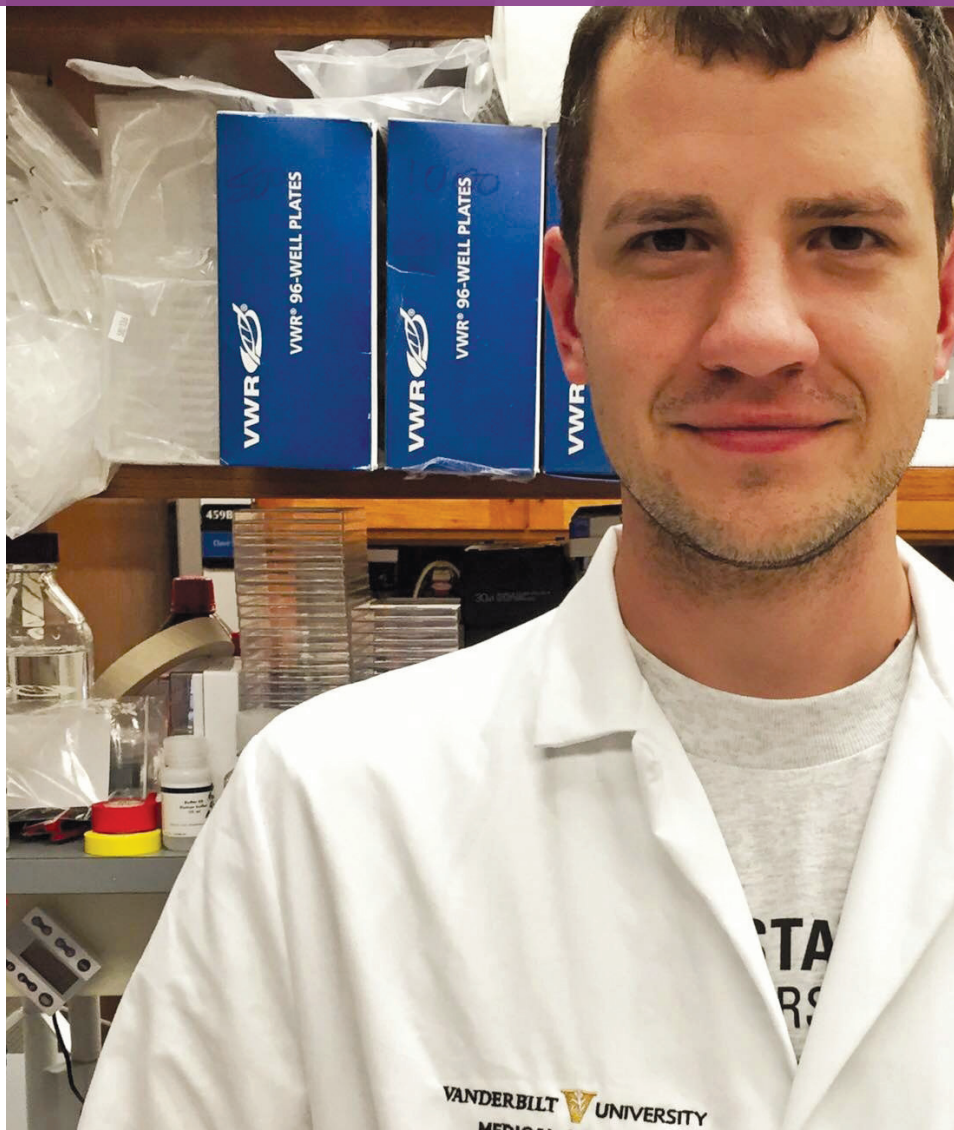

We Offer the Following Two Programs

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT AWARD IN CLINICAL AND TRANSLATIONAL PHARMACOLOGY: The purpose of this award is to support clinical and basic scientists committed to pursuing a career in clinical-translational pharmacology involving both research and training. Award recipients will receive two years of support at \$120,000 per year. Ideal physician candidates will have at least two years of training at the residency level and two years of clinical experience in a research training program related to clinical pharmacology and translational medicine. Non-physician candidates must show experience and opportunity for highly collaborative work with clinicians and patient populations. Detailed eligibility criteria is listed on the website.

PAUL CALABRESI MEDICAL STUDENT RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS: This \$18,000 fellowship offers support to medical/dental students who have substantial interests in

research and teaching careers in pharmacology/clinical and translational pharmacology and who are willing to work full time in a specific research effort.

The principle aim of this program is to generate interest in research careers in pharmacology, including clinical-translational pharmacology, among medical and dental students. Students who are not already in a training sequence leading to a research career or students already in a M.D./Ph.D. program for whom additional financial support is appropriate are both eligible to apply.

Applications and eligibility criteria are available online at www.phrmafoundation.org and the application submission deadline is **February 1, 2019**. All applicants will be notified no later than **April 15, 2019**. These awards may be activated beginning **July 1, 2019**.
